

Prof. S. R. Ranganathan – A Tribute

Remembering the Father of Library Science in India (1892–1972)

The Library Association of Bihar (LAB) pays a heartfelt tribute to Prof. S. R. Ranganathan, the visionary scholar and pioneer of modern library science in India. His groundbreaking contributions continue to inspire librarians, researchers, and information professionals across generations.



Prof. Shiyali Ramamrita Ranganathan, born on August 9, 1892, in Shiyali, Tamil Nadu, is celebrated as the Father of Library Science in India. His pioneering contributions laid the foundation for modern librarianship in the country, transforming libraries into vibrant knowledge hubs.

Key Contributions:

- Five Laws of Library Science (1931): A timeless framework guiding the philosophy and ethics of library service:
 - 1. Books are for use
- 2. Every reader his or her book
- 3. Every book its reader

- 4. Save the time of the reader 5. The library is a growing organism
- Colon Classification System: An innovative faceted classification system that revolutionized how information is organized and retrieved.
- Library Education and Advocacy:
 - o Established the first library science course in India at the University of Madras (1929).
 - o Founded the Indian Library Association (ILA) in 1933.
 - o Advocated for public library legislation and professional standards.
- Influence on Indian Libraries: His vision led to the modernization of libraries across India, fostering equitable access to knowledge for students, researchers, and the general public.

Honors and Legacy:

- Served as University Librarian and Professor of Library Science at Banaras Hindu University and the University of Delhi.
- Recognized globally for his contributions to Library and Information Science (LIS).
- National Library Day is observed on August 12 every year in India to commemorate his birthday.

Prof. Ranganathan's work continues to inspire generations of library professionals. His emphasis on user-centered service, knowledge organization, and continual learning remains deeply relevant in today's digital age.

Heritage Spotlight

Khuda Bakhsh Oriental Library, Patna

Nestled by the Ganges in Patna, the Khuda Bakhsh Oriental Public Library stands as a living legacy of knowledge. Since its inauguration in 1891, it has evolved from a private collection to one of India's greatest repositories of Oriental manuscripts. With over 21,000 rare texts including illustrated chronicles, miniature Qurans, and royal autographs, the library is now embracing the digital age to share its treasures with the world while nurturing scholarship across continents.



History & Founding

- The **Khuda Bakhsh Oriental Public Library** was established by **Khan Bahadur Maulvi Khuda Bakhsh**, who inherited around 1,400 manuscripts from his father. Fulfilling his father's vision of creating a public treasure house of knowledge, he not only expanded the collection but also made it accessible to the public on **29 October 1891.**
- In recognition of its cultural and scholarly significance, the library was granted the status of an Institution of National Importance by an Act of Parliament in 1969. Today, it is administered and fully funded by the Ministry of Culture, Government of India.

Collections & Special Holdings

• The library houses an unparalleled collection of over 21,000 manuscripts in languages such as Arabic, Persian, Urdu, Turkish, Pashto, and Hindi, along with a vast repository of more than 2 million printed books in English, German, French, Russian, Japanese, and several Indian languages.

Among its rarest treasures are:

- Tarikh-e-Khandan-e-Timuriyah, the only surviving illustrated chronicle of Timur and his dynasty.
- A unique copy of Lord Byron's "Ode to Napoleon" with additional handwritten verses.
- A miniature Quran, measuring just 2.5 mm in width.
- Priceless artifacts such as **Nadir Shah's sword**, Mughal miniature paintings, exquisite calligraphy, and manuscripts inscribed on deer skin, palm leaves, and cloth.

Conservation & Digitization

- Serving as a recognized Manuscript Conservation Centre, the library has restored thousands of fragile manuscripts to ensure their longevity.
- A major digitization program is underway, with **over 1.5 million pages already digitized** and around **3.58 lakh folios** available through an in-house e-reading facility. This includes miniature manuscripts, as well as letters and personal writings of eminent figures like **Mahatma Gandhi**, **Jawaharlal Nehru**, **and Dr. Rajendra Prasad**.
- The library also undertakes publication projects, including translations of classical works such as Tarikh-i-Firoz Shahi from Persian to English, and other texts into Hindi, Persian, and Arabic. It has also issued illustrated albums on scientific instruments and the famed **Patna Qalams**.

Research & Publications

- KBOPL is a hub for research in diverse fields such as Islamic studies, Sufism, medieval Indian history, Unani medicine, and comparative religion.
- It organizes seminars, workshops, and academic training programs, while publishing a quarterly research journal since 1977. Facilities like microfilm, photocopying, and reference services are provided to both Indian and international scholars.
- The library also offers research fellowships, free accommodation to scholars, and is recognized as a research center by several universities including Visva-Bharati (Shantiniketan), Jamia Millia Islamia, and Magadh University.

Cultural Significance & Legacy

- Over the years, the library has hosted many distinguished visitors, including Mahatma Gandhi, Rabindranath Tagore, Jawaharlal Nehru, several Viceroys, and four Presidents of India, among them Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam.
- Its manuscripts are regarded as national treasures. The National Mission for Manuscripts has identified several from this collection—such as Kitab al-Tasrif, Kitab al-Hashaish, Tarikh-e-Khandan-e-Timuriyah, and the Divan of Hafez—as part of India's 45 "Manuscript Treasures."
- Today, the Khuda Bakhsh Library continues to attract scholars from across the world, serving as both a guardian of India's cultural heritage and a vibrant center for academic exchange




